Members of the UnitedHealthcare Charter plan need to select a network primary care physician (PCP) – either a general or family practitioner, internist or pediatrician – from Advocate Health Care to guide them with their health care. If a doctor isn't chosen, one will be assigned. The PCP will provide care for the majority of the member's needs, whether it be an annual well visit, preventive care, an illness, or an injury. And because this designated doctor will know the member's history, he or she will best be able to make referrals to other network physicians or specialists.

PCPs are the key to helping members live healthier lives, guiding them through a complex medical system and helping them get the right care at the right time from the appropriate providers. No coverage is provided without a referral. Non-network coverage is not available, except in the case of emergency care.

Note: Members must obtain a referral from their PCP before seeing another Advocate Health Care network physician.

Exceptions include: services from a network OB/GYN, network behavioral health or substance use disorder clinicians or for routine refractive exams from network providers. Certain inpatient and outpatient procedures require that the network physician obtain prior authorization from UnitedHealthcare before the procedure is performed.


